DRAFT AIR OPERATING PERMIT

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seeks comments on a draft Air Operating Permit (AOP) renewal for the following facility:

**Fibrex Corporation
750 S Spruce Street
Burlington, Washington 98233**

Fibrex Corporation (Fibrex) manufactures and provides engineering services for custom fiberglass reinforced plastic composite products. Products include application-specific fiberglass pipe, headers, and duct systems for corrosive industrial applications. Vinyl ester and polyester resins are used, and specifically formulated, to optimize the material for use in corrosive, high-temperature, and fire resistant applications. Fibrex is required to have an AOP because the facility has the potential to emit more than 10 tons per year of styrene, a hazardous air pollutant.

The AOP compiles existing air quality requirements and permits into one comprehensive document and establishes monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting procedures to assure compliance. The AOP does not approve emission increases or require emission decreases. Renewal of the AOP must occur every 5 years. This action is a renewal of the existing AOP. Any such requests must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing the request, and describe why a public hearing is necessary.

NWCAA is publishing this notice pursuant to the Washington State Clean Air Act (RCW 70.94). The AOP is issued pursuant to Chapter 173-401 WAC and Title V of the federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.
