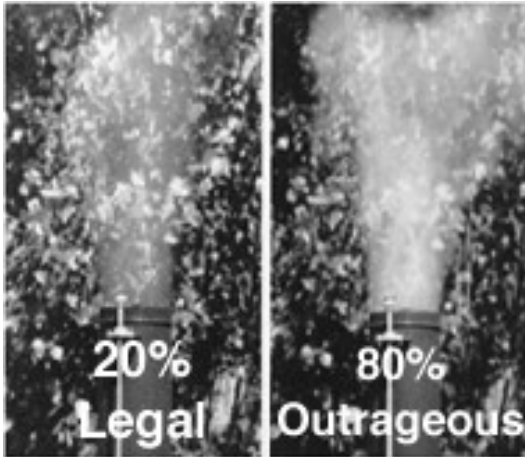

**You are not exempt from other wood smoke laws:**



- Smoke from your chimney is limited to 20% opacity or just a “wisp of smoke”. Excessive chimney smoke is permitted for 20 minutes during startup and 6 minutes once an hour for refueling.
- It is unlawful to burn anything other than clean, dry, untreated wood.
- It is unlawful to impact neighbors with smoke, odor or ash.

**Violation of these laws can result in a fine.**
