DRAFT REVISED ORDER OF APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seeks comments on a draft Revision to an Order of Approval to Construct (OAC) for the following facility:

**Petrogas Ferndale Storage Terminal
4100 Unick Road
Ferndale, WA 98248**

Project Description: The revised OAC will authorize Petrogas to retain the (2) existing reciprocating compressors driven by (2) existing Waukesha Lean Burn natural gas-fired engines for up to 1,000 hours (combined use) for emergency and back-up to the (2) new reciprocating compressors driven by (2) new natural gas-fired Caterpillar Ultra Lean Burn Engines. Modeling was performed to review impacts to ambient air quality from this project.

NWCAA's preliminary determination finds that the project has no adverse impacts to ambient air quality for toxic air pollutants and will comply with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations relating to air quality.

Public Hearing and Comment Period: A public hearing is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on September 5, 2017 at the Ferndale Library at 2125 Main Street in Ferndale, Washington. All persons, including the applicant, may submit verbal comments during the public hearing for the administrative record on this preliminary determination. An open house to answer questions will start at 6:00 p.m., followed by the public hearing at 6:30 p.m. Interested parties may testify at the public hearing and/or submit written comments to Crystal Rau at the address above or by email to crystalr@nwcleanairwa.gov.

The NWCAA will accept comments until the close of business September 6, 2017. All persons, including the applicant, must raise all issues and submit all arguments supporting their position by the end of the comment period. The NWCAA cannot incorporate any supporting materials by reference unless they are already part of the administrative record in the same proceeding, or are generally available reference material.

Final Determination: The NWCAA will send copies of the final determination on the proposed project to all persons who submit comments and have provided a mailing address. The final determination will also be available for review at the NWCAA.

Appealing Decisions: Within 30 calendar days following the NWCAA's final determination on this matter, any person may petition the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) to review any condition of that decision (Chapter 371-08 WAC, and Chapter 43.21B RCW).
