DRAFT ORDER OF APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seek comments on a draft Order of Approval to Construct (OAC) for the following facility:

**BP West Coast Products LLC
Cherry Point Refinery
4519 Grandview Rd
Blaine, WA 98230**

Project Description: The OAC will authorize the BP Cherry Point Refinery to implement the Coker Gas Venting project comprised of adding one booster compressor, piping, instrumentation, and ancillary equipment within the existing Coker Unit (Coker) and Flare Gas Recovery Unit (FGRU) to capture gas during venting of the existing coke drums and decrease coke drum and flaring emissions. The project enables BP to meet regulatory requirements for Coker gas venting and flaring.

NWCAA's preliminary determination finds that the project satisfies the requirement for using best available control technology for regulated air contaminants. It also finds that the project will comply with all applicable local, state and federal regulations established pursuant to Federal and Washington State Clean Air Acts.

Public Hearing and Comment Period: A public hearing is scheduled for 6 p.m. on December 7, 2017, at the Ferndale Library at 2125 Main Street in Ferndale, Washington. All persons, including the applicant, may submit verbal comments during the public hearing for the administrative record on this preliminary determination. Interested parties may testify at the public hearing and/or submit written comments to Robyn Jones at the address above or by email to robynj@nwcleanairwa.gov or info@nwcleanairwa.gov.

The NWCAA will accept comments until the close of business on December 8, 2017. All persons, including the applicant, must raise all issues and submit all arguments supporting their position by the end of this comment period. The NWCAA cannot incorporate any supporting materials by reference unless they are already part of the administrative record in the same proceeding, or are generally available reference material.

Final Determination: The NWCAA will send copies of their final determination on the proposed project to all persons who submit comments and have provided a mailing address to the NWCAA. The final determination will also be available for review at the NWCAA.

Appealing Decisions: Within 30 calendar days following the NWCAA's final determination on this matter, any person may petition the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) to review any condition of that decision (Chapter 371-08 WAC, and Chapter 43.21B RCW).
