NORTHWEST CLEAN AIR AGENCY DRAFT RENEWAL TO AIR OPERATING PERMIT

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seeks comments on a draft renewal to the Air Operating Permit for the following facility:

AIR LIQUIDE LARGE INDUSTRIES U.S. LP 8581 South Texas Road Anacortes, WA 98221

The AOP compiles existing air quality requirements and permits into one comprehensive document and establishes monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting procedures to assure compliance. The AOP does not, in itself, approve any emission increases or decreases.

The proposed draft renewal is to the existing Air Liquide AOP issued on March 20, 2013. This renewal incorporates newly applicable federal regulations, new construction permits, corrects typos, and clarifies AOP monitoring requirements.

Air Liquide operates a Steam Methane Reformer to provide hydrogen and steam to the adjacent Puget Sound Refinery.

Air Liquide has been determined to be a support facility to the Puget Sound Refinery and is therefore a major source required to obtain an Air Operating Permit pursuant to Title V of the 1990 Federal Clean Air Act and chapter 173-401 of the Washington Administrative Code.

Any such requests must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing the request, and describe why a public hearing is necessary.
