REQUEST FOR STAKEHOLDER INPUT ON REGULATION REVISIONS AFFECTING SPRAY COATERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) is requesting preliminary input from stakeholders on a draft spray coating regulation.

Highlights of Draft Requirements

- 1. Spray coating must be conducted in an enclosure*
- 2. Filtration must be used
- 3. Approved spray application methods are required (e.g., HVLP, airless or air-assisted, other methods specified by the product manufacturer)
- 4. A vertical unobstructed exhaust stack that vents above the eave of the roof is required*
- 5. No visible emissions from exhaust vents are allowed
- 6. Spray guns must be disassembled and cleaned by hand or cleaned in an enclosed cleaning device
- 7. VOC-containing materials must be kept in closed containers
- 8. Record keeping is required (e.g., usage or purchase volumes, weekly visible filter checks, weekly pressure drop readings, disposal records)
- 9. We recognize that the rule requirements can't be met in some cases. We're proposing exemptions for things like:
 - Spray coating objects that are too big to fit in a booth
 - Spray coating stationary structures (e.g. bridges)
 - Aerosol spray can use
 - Coatings applications like truck bed liners, fiberglass resin and gel coats, powder coatings, metallizing, electrodeposition coatings
 - Coatings applied without spraying (e.g., using paint brushes, rollers, flow coaters)
