### **NORTHWEST CLEAN AIR AGENCY DRAFT REGULATORY ORDER FOR VOLUNTARY FACILITY-WIDE STYRENE AIR EMISSION LIMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action and seeks comments on the issuance of a draft Regulatory Order to the following facility:

**Nordic Tugs Inc.  
11367 Higgins Airport Way  
Burlington, WA 98233**

Project Description: Nordic Tugs owns and operates a fiberglass boat manufacturing facility. The facility is requesting a Regulatory Order to limit facility-wide styrene air emissions from existing manufacturing operations to less than ten tons per year.

Comment Period: NWCAA will accept comments until the close of business on October 30, 2018. All persons, including the applicant, must raise all issues and submit all arguments supporting their position by the end of this comment period. NWCAA cannot incorporate any supporting materials by reference unless they are already part of the administrative record in the same proceeding, or are generally available reference material.

A public hearing may be held if NWCAA determines that there is significant public interest. Requests for a public hearing must be submitted within the comment period. Any such requests must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing the request, and describe why a public hearing is necessary.

Final Determination: NWCAA will send copies of the final determination on the proposed project to all persons who submit comments and have provided a mailing address to NWCAA. The final determination will also be available for review at the NWCAA office.

Appealing Decisions: NWCAA's final decision may be appealed to the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board no later than 30 days after the date that the order is served, as provided by state law. Please contact the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board at (360) 664-9160 for details regarding appeal procedures.

NWCAA is publishing this Notice pursuant to the Washington State Clean Air Act (chapter 70.94 RCW). The Regulatory Order is issued pursuant to WAC 173-400-091 and NWCAA Section 121.
