REGULATORY ORDER 47

Project Summary: Facility-wide limit on emissions of styrene.

Pursuant to your request and the provisions set forth in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-400-091 and NWCAA Regulation Section 121, you are hereby ordered to operate your facility subject to the following limits:

- (1) Limit facility-wide air emission of styrene (CAS No. 100-42-5) to less than ten tons during any consecutive 12-month period.
- (2) Within 30 days after the end of each month:
 - (a) calculate air emissions of styrene emitted during the previous month, and
 - (b) calculate the total air emissions of styrene emitted during the previous consecutive 12-month period.
- (3) Maintain all records generated pursuant to Condition 2 for at least three years and make records available to Northwest Clean Air Agency personnel upon request.
- (4) Notify the Northwest Clean Air Agency, in writing, within 30 days after the end of each consecutive 12-month period if, during that period, facility-wide air emissions of styrene exceeded 9.0 tons.
- (5) At all times, for the entire facility, comply with the requirements of 40 CFR 63 Subpart VVVV, the Boat Manufacturing National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants, as they apply to major sources.
