PUBLIC NOTICENorthwest Clean Air Agency Draft Regulatory Order (RO 31C)

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action and seeks comments on a draft permit revision to Regulatory Order 31, for:

Dakota Creek 820 Fourth Street Anacortes, WA 98221

Dakota Creek is a shipyard that performs vessel maintenance. In 2007 the facility applied for and obtained Regulatory Order 31 (RO 31) to voluntarily limit facility-wide emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOC) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs). The facility now requests the third revision to RO 31, revision C. In this revision, the facility requests that NWCAA clarify permit language and align the emission reporting deadline and certification requirements with NWCAA's current rules and business processes. No changes to the permit limits (VOC or HAPs) will be made. No equipment will be added or removed.

Public comment is open from 4/29/21 until 5/31/21.

Comment Period: NWCAA will accept comments until the close of business on 5/31/21. All persons, including the applicant, must raise all issues and submit all arguments supporting their position by the end of this comment period.

Hearing: NWCAA may hold a public hearing on RO-31c if we determine that there is significant public interest. No hearing is scheduled at this time.

Final Determination: NWCAA will send copies of its final Order and response to comments to everyone who submitted comments and provided a mail or email address.

Appealing Decisions: Within 30 calendar days following NWCAA's final determination on this matter, any person may petition the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) to review any condition of that decision (Chapter 371-08 WAC, and Chapter 43.21B RCW).
