PUBLIC NOTICE

NORTHWEST CLEAN AIR AGENCY DRAFT ORDER OF APPROVAL TO CONSTRUCT FOR EMISSIONS OF AIR CONTAMINANTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action and seeks comments on TWO draft permits, known as an Order of Approval to Construct (OAC):

1. Draft OAC 289b
2. Draft OAC 305b

Regarding the following facility:

**BP Products North America, Inc.
BP Cherry Point Refinery
4519 Grandview Road
Blaine, WA 98230**

Public comment is open from June 10, 2021 to July 12, 2021.

Project Descriptions:

1. Draft OAC 289b: The BP Cherry Point Refinery (BP) requests a revision to an existing permit to install two additional cooling tower cells at the existing #2 Cooling Tower to increase the total heat release rate from 500 MMBtu/hour to 750 MMBtu/hour.
2. Draft OAC 305b: BP requests a revision to an existing permit to streamline the hydrogen sulfide (H₂S) limits for the #2 Reformer Heater fuel gas system. The proposed changes are:
 - a. Increase limit from 160 parts per million (ppm), 3-hour average to 162 ppm, 3-hour average, and,
 - b. Decrease limit from 90 ppm, calendar month average to 50 ppm, 24-hour rolling average.

These changes will align the limits in the NWCAA permit with applicable federal regulations and additional fuel gas system requirements. No physical modification to the #2 Reformer Heater or fuel gas system is proposed.

NWCAA modified previously-issued permits (OAC 289a and OAC 305a) that will limit emissions of regulated air contaminants. NWCAA is proposing to issue the permits as modified.

Public Review: Interested parties may view the draft OACs and associated technical support documents online at <https://nwcleanairwa.gov/public-notices/>.

Comment Period: NWCAA will accept comments until the close of business on July 12, 2021. All persons, including the applicant, must raise all issues and submit all arguments

supporting their position by the end of this comment period. NWCAA cannot incorporate any supporting materials by reference unless they are already part of the administrative record in the same proceeding, or are generally available reference material.

Public Hearing: NWCAA may hold public hearings on the draft OACs if the agency determines that there is significant public interest. However, hearings are not scheduled at this time.

Final Determination: NWCAA will send copies of the final determinations on the proposed projects to all persons who submit comments and have provided a mailing address.

Appealing Decisions: Any final Order issued by NWCAA may be appealed to the Washington State Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) no later than 30 days after the date that the order is served, as provided by state law.
