

**Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) hereby issues
Order of Approval to Construct (OAC) 1381**

- (1) Odors from the facility must not result in a nuisance at or beyond the property boundary as determined by NWCAA staff.
- (2) Keep doors to each rackhouse closed at all times except when barrels are being delivered or removed from it.
