PUBLIC NOTICE
NORTHWEST CLEAN AIR AGENCY
DRAFT AIR OPERATING PERMIT – RENEWAL

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seeks comments on a draft Air Operating Permit (AOP) renewal for the following facility:

TESORO REFINING AND MARKETING COMPANY LLC
Anacortes Refinery
10200 West March Point Road
Anacortes, WA 98221

The Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company LLC (Tesoro) owns and operates a petroleum refinery (Anacortes Refinery) near Anacortes, Washington, located at the northern end of March's Point. The Anacortes refinery receives crude oil, catalytic cracking unit feed, and other petroleum derivatives and materials, and ships finished petroleum products, feed stocks, byproducts, intermediates, and wastes via various forms of transportation, and manufactures petroleum fuels. The refinery is a designated major source for the AOP program because the facility has the potential to emit more than 100 tons of carbon monoxide, nitrogen oxides, sulfur oxides, particulate matter less than ten microns in size, volatile organic compounds, and more than 25 tons per year of combined Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) and more than 10 tons per year of a single HAP. These air pollutants are defined as regulated air pollutants in chapter 173-401 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC).

The AOP compiles existing air quality requirements and permits into one comprehensive document and establishes monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting procedures to assure compliance. The AOP does not approve emission increases or require emission decreases. This action renews the permit to incorporate revised construction approval orders and new regulations that apply to this type of facility. Any such requests must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing the request and describe why a public hearing is necessary.

NWCAA is publishing this notice pursuant to the Washington State Clean Air Act (ch 70A.15 RCW). The AOP is issued pursuant to chapter 173-401 WAC and Title V of the federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.
