1. Introductions – All present introduced themselves and identified their role at work and in the community.

2. Approval of January 10, 2024, meeting summary

Carl – Currently, we have not heard back from DNR as to the grant but ready when it comes through.

6. Wood stove replacement update:

Mark – No current updates of how many were completed. Currently, 13 recipients are at different stages of the changeout program.

7. WOOD BANK update -

Dean relayed to Seth prior to the meeting that the Wood Bank has 3 cords on hand and plans to build it up to 20 by next Fall.

9. NW Clean Air update

Seth - These are the exceedances of the PM2.5 standard since 1/10/2024:

- 1/21: 37.5 ug/m3
- 1/22: 51.7 ug/m3
- 1/23: 37.5 ug/m3
- 1/24: 38.2 ug/m3
- 2/19: 36 ug/m3

There were 6 complaints for 1221 Hopeful Valley Lane in February 2024.
