NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) will take action on and seeks comments on draft Order of Approval to Construct (OAC) 1439 for:

HF Sinclair Puget Sound Refinery
8505 S Texas Road
Anacortes, WA 98221

If approved, OAC 1439 will permit the installation of a new standby non-emergency engine (671 hp) at the HF Sinclair Puget Sound Refinery (PSR) to replace an existing emergency engine (230 hp) for powering a process unit control room in case of electrical power interruption. The new proposed engine will be permitted as non-emergency, limited to 900 hours per year, and may be used in multiple applications throughout the facility as needed.

PSR is a petroleum refinery in Anacortes, Washington. The refinery is capable of processing approximately 150,000 barrels per day of crude oil into petroleum products including gasoline, distillate fuels, fuel oils, and petroleum coke.
