



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD and HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the Northwest Clean Air Agency (NWCAA) seeks comments on draft Order of Approval to Construct (OAC) 1430 for:

**Williams – Northwest Pipeline LLC
Sumas Compressor Station
4738 Jones Road
Sumas, WA 98295**

If approved, OAC 1430 will permit the installation of a new Solar Mars 100 turbine (144 MMBtu/hr) at the Sumas Compressor Station to replace an existing Solar Mars 90 turbine (100 MMBtu/hr).

Williams Northwest Pipeline LLC (NW Pipeline) operates a natural gas pipeline system from the Washington-Canada border near Sumas, Washington to the San Juan Gas Fields in New Mexico. The gas pipeline system serves commercial, industrial, utility, and cogeneration customers in Washington, Oregon, Nevada, and California.

The project at the Sumas Compressor Station is part of the larger Huntingdon Connector Project, which includes the installation of a turbine at the NW Pipeline compressor station in Snohomish WA. Public comment for the Snohomish project will be announced by Puget Sound Clean Air Agency (PSCAA), <https://psccleanair.gov/175/Permits-Open-for-Comment>. Submit comments related to the Snohomish project to PSCAA.

State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) review is required for the Huntingdon Connector Project. The public comment for the SEPA review will run from June 15 to June 30.
